16	<b><u>HEAT ILLNESS PREVENTION</u></b> (morning) The two most effective tools for employee protection in any workplace are knowledge and awareness of hazards. This <b>4-hour Heat Illness Prevention Workshop</b> covers the requirements of <b>Section 3395</b> with the goal of arming the participants with the skills to recognize risk factors and symptoms associated with heat illness. 16	<b><u>CHEMICAL HAZARDS/HAZARD COMMUNICATION (AFTERNOON)</u></b> This course covers Hazard Communication including definitions and Cal/OSHA standards promulgated under the Federal OSHA Standard. It also introduces the GHS system, adopted by OSHA and Cal/OSHA in 2012, and replaces MSDS's, emphasizes the importance of training all target audiences to recognize and interpret label and/or SDS information, and to take appropriate action in response to chemical hazards.
